So that America can go on carousing; that the great cities' night life and its midnight orgies may continue unmolested; that the breweries can go on brewing their abominable poisons for the turning out of more drunkards; that the tobacco companies can continue to turn America's young women into cigarette fiends; so that debauchery and every evil can continue unrestrained. Awful Price of Compromising With Red God-Haters

Bible prophecy has shown so clearly (all prophetic scholars are agreed) that Russia was the great Rosh of Ezekiel, which was to come down in the time of the end, seeking to destroy civilization. Since the rise of Communism there has never been anything secret about its policy, its purpose and determination. It has blasphemed God, destroyed the church from the land, murdered millions of Christians, boasted of world conquest and elsewhere conducted itself as a sadistic beast, all of which was enough to make the blood of decent people turn cold. Yet America, for the sake of a few dollars in trade, recognized Red Russia during the heart of the depression and permitted her to re-enter the family of nations. Moreover, this vile cancer of Communism was permitted to grow and flourish unhindered in America. Later, when Russia connived with Hitler for the rape of Poland, thus precipitating the horrors of World War II, she further showed her beast-like nature by invading little Finland without provocation. America looked on with horror. But as soon as Hitler and Stalin fell out, we promptly forgot all these things, and thought that we would save our own skins by sending our treasure to Russia. Yes, eighteen billion dollars worth of guns and war ma-

terial saved Red Russia from falling before the hosts of the Nazis. Thus we thwarted the two beasts of Nazism and Communism from fighting each other to a finish, and by so doing gave the preponderance of power to Russia, our sworn enemy. Had we dispatched our help to Chiang-Kai-Shek, who was at least a nominal Christian, we would have saved Asia from the curse of Communism. But our nation did not take God into consideration and sinned against light; now it faces the hour of reckoning.

Hour of Reckoning at Hand

Will the Korean conflict end in a few weeks with victory on our side, as was supposed when the North Koreans first crossed the 38th parallel on June 25th? "Just a little police action by the U. N.," some of our leaders said. "Let business continue as usual." Now at the present moment, a little over a month later, we are reduced to a beachhead, and our boys are fighting against overwhelming odds. Each day they have been forced to make a "strategic" retreat. Who is so foolish as to believe that this is a war waged only by North Korea? Red Russia conceived and planned it and has ordered the strategy. Is any one naive enough to think that the little army of North Korea could drive back the armies of America in the fashion that has taken place? Russia has planned it all along. It is her tanks, her guns and war material that our boys are facing. How our State Department was so taken off guard has been hard for even Congress to understand.

What Next?

Russia cannot afford to lose Korea without losing face. It is her war, not Korea's. She must maintain her prestige. So must America. Unless some very remarkable incident takes place, this conflict will spread until it becomes universal and the world will gravitate into the throes of Armageddon. Russia. holding the balance of power in a European land thrust, believes that she can quickly overcome any opposition with the overwhelming power of hundreds of trained divisions. American armaments are now pouring into Asia and Europe in a race against time. Every day Europe becomes stronger. Will Russia prolong the issue much longer before she strikes elsewhere and eventually southward toward Palestine?

America Soon To Be Under Controls

Already controls are being thrust upon industry. Soon they will come again upon civilian life. The draft has again become a fact. Calls for the guard units and the reserve have gone forth, and national mobilization looms in the immediate future.

The Atomic Bomb

So far, the atomic bomb has not been used. Russia slyly waits for America first to bring it into action in order to give her an excuse to use it; for America is far more vulnerable to atomic warfare than Russia. The latter's industries have been moved eastward since the days when Hitler invaded Russia. In the Ural mountains and underground, much of the manufacturing of war materials for the Soviets is taking place. In remote areas, Russia is manufacturing the atomic bomb. Our A-bomb plants are located in comparatively accessible and well known areas. Russia is in a possible position to destroy our A-bomb productivity and at the same time maintain her own. Our factories have not dispersed and are highly vulnerable to atomic warfare. There are some terrible surprises ahead for America, of which Pearl Harbor was a minor blow by comparison.

Atomic Destruction—The Great Dispersion

Within the next three years we expect to see the most profound convulsions of history taking place. Men have increased their power to destroy, since the last war, some 20,000 times. Other hitherto undisclosed secret weapons will come forth. Russia, no doubt, has some of her own. She perhaps would not attempt this bold thrust of the present moment if she did not have some strong promise of victory. Jesus said, "Except the days be shortened, no flesh would be saved." Thank God, those days will be shortened.

American coastlines are threatened. Schnorkel submarines, which can breathe under water, and which travel at a speed that makes them difficult to detect by sonar, can approach our coasts and launch rockets with atomic warheads that could wreak destruction in our large cities in a degree beyond description. New York City is contemplating spending two billions of dollars for underground shelters in a desperate bid for survival. Perhaps there will be a great dispersion of the population inland. If this should happen it is easy to see that our entire national economy will convulse, and the foundations of society be laid bare. Also, we shudder as we think of the vulnerability of our ally, England. The mainland of Europe, of course, will be sucked into the orbit of the Beast Pow-

er, but some believe that England will try to escape from atomic destruction by flight to Canada. In World War II, she attempted dispersion of her children from London. Now the situation is incredibly more threatening.

Revivals May Be Curtailed



The time for great revival efforts may be drawing to a close, although we hope that a little time of respite may be granted. Certainly it is advisable to make as good use of the time as is possible, for "the night cometh when no man can work." If time were reversed and we found ourselves living in the hour just before the Flood, what would be our mode of life? How sober our thoughts would be as we realized that an entire civilization was about to be wiped out. Yet we are living in a comparative time. The antediluvian race laughed and joked, made merry, gave in marriage, divorced, drank, rioted, debauched, and ignored altogether the warnings of the coming of judgment. Then came the moment when God shut the door of the ark, and the hour of mercy for that ill-fated generation was gone forever. The Flood came. Sudden destruction and irrevocable ruin swept the ante-diluvian world into oblivion. As it was in the days of Noah, so Jesus said it would be in the days of the coming of the Son of man. God grant that when that moment comes, every person who reads these words will find a haven inside the Ark of Safety. That haven is only reached by a sincere repentance for sins, and faith in our Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ!



QUESTION: Since Divine Healing is so clearly taught in the Scriptures, and is found as an ordinance in Exodus 15, where the Lord reveals himself as "Jehovah Rapha, the Lord that heal-eth thee" (Exod. 15:25-26); and, in Psalms 103:3, the Lord is eth thee" (Exod. 15:25-26); and, in Psalms 103:3, the Lord is spoken of as the One "Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases"; and since Jesus from the beginning of His ministry conducted healing campaigns and healed the sick (Matt. 4:23-25); and, after Him the apostles also conducted

ANSWER: Many and varied are the reasons that cause some to oppose the ministry of healing. It has been aptly said that every man has two reasons-one that sounds good, and, second, the real reason. Underlying every action of man is a mo-tive, although there are times when a per-son will not admit even to himself his real motive for doing a certain thing. Thus those who oppose the teaching of Divine Healing advance many supposed objections against this ministry. It is charged that those who pray for the sick claim to be "Divine Healers," that they are in it only for the money, that no real healings take place, or when healings are demonstrated. such are the work of the devil who per-forms "signs and wonders," to fool the people, or that the soul is more important than the body, etc., etc. But these are not the real reasons for the opposition and in-deed are almost entirely false. They are ammunition however to use among the uninformed, and they cover up the real mo-tive. Since opposers of the ministry of Divine Healing are not likely to bare the real underlying reasons for their opposi-tion, let us turn to the Scriptures for the answer.

1. TRADITIONS OF MEN ALLOWED TO HAVE PRECEDENCE OVER THE WORD OF GOD. This was an initial fault of the Pharisees which led them into such glaring errors. Jesus declared that they glaring errors. Jesus declared that they transgressed "the commandments of God by (their) tradition." Matt. 15:3. It is a notable fact that an unspiritual religious man is inclined to accept human traditions that have been handed down, rather than the Word of God. The Word of God cuts even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit. The traditions of men are adapted to conform to habits and nature of fallen man. Impressionable youth is caught in the toils of this system, and if they have had no vital contact with God, accept and continue the propagation of false teaching, thus error is perpetuated from generation to generation. (Matt. 23:15). Many of those who attack Divine Healing have been taught in the seminary the tradition which is utterly unscriptural "that the days of miracles are past." They are merely repeat-ing what has been taught them. The sad ing what has been taught them. The sad thing is that if the young men had been left to their own consciences in reading the cepted the plain truths concerning Divine Healing without a question. But they have been deceived by listening to the same voice that Eve heard, "Yea, hath God said?". Scriptures, many of them would have ac-

HUMAN PRIDE. Once committed publicly to a certain position, it is very difficult for the average man to change, even though the strongest reasons show that he is in error. Pride entered the heart of a once pure archangel and caused him to fall from heaven. That being the case we should not be surprised that this evil emotion should seek entrance into hearts of professed followers of Christ. The op-poser of the teaching of Divine Healing finds a wall of truth standing against him. Frustrated, he seeks to strengthen his position through controversy and debate. may issue a challenge for a miracle to be wrought before him, and when such pro-fane challenge is disregarded, he mistakenly believes he has scored a victory. Herod showed respect to the teaching of Christ up till the time that the Lord refused to perform a miracle for him. After that he joined himself with His murderers. (Luke 23:6-12). As for the Pharisees, they never changed their position until they were in hell. (Matt. 23:23).
3. LACK OF COMPASSION. When

Jesus met the woman who was bowed over with an infirmity for eighteen years, He declared the affliction was caused by Satan, and He loosed her on the Sabbath Day. (Luke 13:10-17). The ruler of the synagogue was indignant and protested against healing on the Sabbath Day. Jesus answer-ed him by calling him a hypocrite, and pointed out that he was perfectly willing to water his animals on the Sabbath Day, but he had no compassion for this poor woman whom Satan had bound for eighteen years. It is evident that Christ not only healed to demonstrate the power of God, but also the healing was an outflowing of His compassion to the afflicted person. Many professed religionists are as the Pharisee mentioned above—they have little or no feeling for the sick and afflicted. We once witnessed a debater rant against Divine Heal-ing before a crowd of hopelessly sick. Ap-

parently their sickness and misery had no meaning to him. But there is one cure for this type of people, and we have seen it work more times than one. The fact is that as long as it is the other fellow that suffers, they think nothing of it. But when afflic-tion comes to them and their own hide is in danger, they begin to see Divine Heal-ing in a different light. When hope in human aid is gone, and the arm of flesh has failed, people, not a few times, have been known to seek help from the source

healing meetings (Acts 5:12-16; 8:5-8; I Cor. 2:1-5, etc., etc.) and believers were commanded to pray for the sick (Mark 16:16;

James 5:14-16), and whereas, they were also charged in the last

words of Jesus, when He gave them the great Commission, to preach and teach others to observe the same things that Christ had taught His disciples, why then do many who profess to believe in the verbal inspiration of the Scriptures, oppose the ministry

> that they previously spurned. 4. JEALOUSY. Nothing is more ap-parent in the record of the Gospels than the jealousy that was aroused in the hearts of the Pharisees because of the miracles of the Lord. (Matt. 9:33-34.) This greeneyed monster was the main factor in their downfall, and in fact goaded them on to such unreasoning fury that they committed the crime of the ages—murder of the Saviour. What a paradox that these religionists who claimed to have the greatest light of their day, allowed themselves through the passion of jealousy to commit the crime of Deicide!

> Human nature has not changed. Perhaps the greatest source of opposition to the healing ministry today is jealousy. As all over the land, thousands upon thousands of people are attending the healing campaigns, ecclesiastics see that public atten-tion and confidence is shifting from them to those who dare to believe God's prom-ises. As a result they are filled with re-sentment, and thus the stage is set for a reenactment of the opposition which took place in the days of Jesus. 5. A LUKEWARM MINISTRY. Jesus

> said rather pointedly to the cavilling Phari-sees, "By whom do your sons cast out (devils)?" They had no answer. Their superficial and hypocritical life possessed no power to cast out devils. The achieving of a successful healing minister calls for of a successful healing ministry calls for a deep consecration of the one so used, and demands a living faith in God, of a de-gree which was quite beyond the pale of a Pharisee's experience. (Mark 9:39).

> If one is to have power with God, he must humble himself and earnestly seek the face of God. One may possess an intense measure of fleshly activity and yet be spiritually lazy. It is not easy to deny the flesh and get down on one's knees and seek God. It is easier to tell a sick man to go and have an operation, rather than pray the prayer of faith for him. It is easier to tell a man that his sickness is the will of God, or that he is suffering for the glory of God, or that there is some circumstance in the mysterious Providence of God, which makes it necessary for him to be sick, than it is to bring the Bible message of deliverance to him

Of all the inconsistencies, perhaps this is one of the worst: To tell a sick man that it is not the will of God for him to be healed, but that he should go to a good surgeon and be operated on, thus inferring that

physician may overrule the will of God! The above reasons will not be admitted by those who oppose the healing ministry, but ugly as they are, they are the true causes of the opposition as revealed by the Word of God.

"Greatest Religious Awakening in Decades" Say 22 Cooperating Pastors of Osborn Scranton Campaign

T HE great healing meeting held by the Osborn Evangelistic party in Scranton, Pa., is probably the greatest religious awakening this part of the country has experienced in several decades and undoubtedly the largest Pentecostal revival this section has ever seen.

Twenty-two churches cooperated to make this meeting one tremendous success. Assemblies within a radius of 30 miles closed most of their regular meetings to attend this revival, and visitors came from many hundreds of miles to be present.


As to the results of this meeting: Only eternity can give an accurate account. There were days when over a hundred flocked to the prayer room for salvation. A large percentage of these were Catholic, as this section of the state is strongly Catholic. One of the workers was dealing with a woman and suddenly discovered she was talking to the Gypsy fortune teller she used to go to before being saved. Many nationalities were represented among the converts.

While it is difficult to estimate accurately the number of conversions, we can say there were a large number, nearly 1,800.

It is impossible to tell even a part of the many miracles God performed in healing people. A very large number were prayed for. If any particular group of sufferers received help it was the deaf, for many received their hearing. One child of 3½ years who had been born deaf, received her hearing and a check some time after the healing confirmed the permanence of this miracle. On several occasions waves of healing swept over the congregation and group praying was resorted to. Many received their healing during such times.

Numbers cannot tell the true story. Backsliders have been reclaimed; many sinners saved; large numbers healed; believers quickened in their Christian experience and this entire community set on fire for God.

On the fourth night of the current Campaign in Harrisburg, Pa., conducted by Rev. and Mrs. T. L. Osborn, nearly 6,000 persons crowded the huge tent to capacity. Some of the most outstanding miracles ever to be called to our attention were recorded in the Osborn Pennsylvania revivals this summer.



T HE above are three of the miracles which were wrought during the last three nights of the Scranton campaign, on the crowds of Gypsy people who attended the closing nights of the great revival. One Gypsy man had been healed of a stroke and went home and began to tell his people about his miraculous healing. In three days, Gypsies were coming from every part of the east, including Delaware, Connecticut, New York City, Philadelphia, New Jersey, and many other localities. Scores of them were wonderfully saved, and promised to devote their lives to Christ, find a good church home and attend regularly. Many of them promised to find different occupations than those with which they had formerly made their livings. It was amazing to see the simple faith of these people. They all believed that if they could only get to Brother Osborn, "the Saint," as they called him, that God's blessing would be on them thereafter. Almost everything outward that was wrong with them was instantly healed so that the audience could see the miracles. Ruptures disappeared, their goitres vanished, their blind received sight, their deaf heard, and their lame walked.

Some were reluctant when they saw them come by the hundreds, but the Evangelist said he was right at home; that it was a perfect replica of the Cuba and Puerto Rico campaigns. Who knows but what, in those nights of God's Spirit moving amongst the Gypsies, another "GYPSY SMITH" was chosen by the Master, and anointed to follow the footsteps of that man from a poor Gypsy Camp who won so many thousands to Christ the world over.

"A Strange Challenge"

In the Life of Rev. William Branham

By GORDON LINDSAY

Chapter I

T HE doors of the great municipal auditorium of the City of Portland, Oregon, were opened early that November evening of the year 1947. At six o'clock many people had already stood in line for a long time awaiting opportunity to enter and secure a choice seat. When the caretaker at the appointed time went his rounds to unlock the doors, he was somewhat puzzled to find such a large crowd awaiting him. It was a little strange, he observed, for there had been no unusual advertising, and religious services, even when extensively advertised, as he remembered, rarely attracted enough people to fill more than a fraction of the auditorium.

The caretaker could have noticed also that the people did not follow the common custom in church services of filling up the center and rear pews first, but rather rushed forward to get the seats nearest the front. But soon these were gone, and those toward the rear and in the balconies were occupied also. Once more the caretaker had reason to take note, for firemen assigned to the routine duty of seeing that city ordinances regarding public safety were observed sent word to him that the building was full and that he must at once shut the doors and see that no one else entered.

There was, perhaps, more than one unusual feature to this meeting. Ministers from the ranks of many denominations occupied a large section of seats on the platform. If all who were in the auditorium were counted, they undoubtedly would have numbered several hundred. Such a gathering of local and out-of-city ministers to a revival service was a rare occurrence in the city, and no doubt had never been witnessed on such a scale before.

What was the attraction that had brought together this large concourse of people? It was not the singing or the special music. For although both were excellent and inspiring, yet it was evident that the people were waiting with restrained impatience until the preliminaries would be concluded in anticipation of what was to follow.

The cause of this large gathering could be stated in few words. It had been told over the city that a man by the name of William Branham was coming to town and would speak in the Municipal Auditorium. Concerning this man, it was said that an angel had appeared to him in a special visitation, and gifts of healing were being manifest in his ministry. For, believe it or not, despite the trend of materialistic think-

ing that has engulfed the intelligentsia and the schools of learning of our day, it is evident that deep down in the heart of the human being there does and always will exist a longing for the manifestation of the power of the supernatural. Man lives a fleeting, fragile life in a world marked everywhere by decay, disintegration and death. Materialistic and modernistic theology, which have nothing to offer man one moment after his death, can not satisfy the inherent longing of the human soul for survival. In the world confused by a thousand conflicting voices, each claiming authority and clamoring for recognition, it is not unnatural that man should long for some visible manifestation of the power of God to confirm and attest to the genuineness of the message of those who speak. Jesus did not deny this fundamental urge and desire of the human soul, for He declared, "I am the Son of God. If I do not the works of my Father, believe me not. But if I do, though ye believe not me, believe the works: that ye may know, and believe, that the Father is in me, and I in Him." (Jn. 10:36-38)

The services of the first two nights aroused tremendous interest; and now on the third night the building was filled with people awaiting again for the speaker to appear. The writer, who was directing this brief campaign, in preparing to turn the service over to the evangelist asked the people to stand to their feet and sing the chorus, "Only believe, only believe, all things are possible, only believe." While the great congregation sang, a slight little man with modest demeanor and a friendly smile entered, then came and stood behind the pulpit. The singing ceased, and a hush fell over the audience as it listened intently as he began to speak. As he proceeded, it was apparent that the listeners were impressed by the graciousness of the speaker as well as his evident sincerity and hu-mility. "Yes," said he, "All things are pos-sible to him that believeth. There is nothing that can stand before faith in God, and if the people here tonight will believe God

with me, we shall see that God will honor that faith and confirm it before the eyes of this entire congregation."

As the audience listened with rapt attention to the slight little figure on the platform, perhaps only one anticipated the startling drama that was about to unfold. Certainly the director had no such intuition, and the interruption which was about to occur would not have been more unwelcome. For suddenly our attention was directed to a man far back in the building who was making rapid strides, apparently in the direction of the platform. At first we supposed that some emergency had arisen; perhaps someone had fainted or had taken seriously ill in the auditorium. But as he drew near, we observed with no little misgiving that his countenance bore a demoniac grin, as to suggest that the man was demented, or violently insane, and apparently had broken away from those who had him in their care. We were to learn later what indeed would have been more disturbing had we known it at the time, that the man was not insane, in that he did not know what he was doing, but was a notorious and vicious character who had previously run afoul of the law for disturbing and breaking up religious services. Jail sentences had not taught him a lesson, and now seeing his opportunity to cause a large commotion and again break up a service, he had come forward for that purpose.

Up the steps he strode without pausing. Now he was on the platform assuming a menacing attitude that by this time was attracting the attention of the entire con-gregation. Two sturdy policemen standing in the wings, becoming aware of the dis-traction, were about to come forward and lay hands on this disturber, but we could see that this would result in a scuffle and the excitement created could well ruin the service. Moreover, the evangelist had ap-parently put himself on the spot for he had just declared that all things were possible to him that believed, and that God would always back up His servants who put their trust in Him. Indeed, the meeting had reached such a high state of expectation, that reliance on the officers of the law, though perhaps entirely justifiable in the present instance, did not seem to be the Divine order. We knew nothing else to do but to hastily wave the officers back, and call attention to the evangelist as to what was taking place. But he himself was already conscious that something was wrong. Speaking quietly to the audience and requesting that the people unite with him in silent prayer, he turned to meet the strange challenge of this evil antagonist.

As he did so, the man with the evil gleam on his countenance, which reminded one of the hideous grins the heathen engrave on the faces of their idols, began to impudently accuse and curse the speaker. "You are of the devil, and deceiving the people," he shouted, "an imposter, a snake in the grass, a fake, and I am going to show these people that you are!" It was a bold challenge and every one in that audience could see that it was not an idle threat. As the intruder continued to revile the evangelist, hissing and spitting, he made motion to carry his threats into execution. To the audience it appeared to be an evil moment for the little figure on the platform, and most of them must have felt exceedingly sorry for him. The officers attempted again to come to his aid but were waved away, and now in rejecting their assistance the speaker had deliberately accepted the challenge of this wicked antagonist whose size and fierceness had convinced the audience that he was well able to carry out his boasts. No doubt, critics who had slipped into the auditorium out of curiosity expected a climax. Certainly they could see that there was no room for trickery. The

man on the platform would have to have the goods or else take the consequences.

In the moment of suspense that followed, one could not help being reminded of the story of the challenge of long ago, when the bold Goliath cursed little David in the name of his gods, and boasted that he would tear him limb from limb. The startled congregation, as the hosts of Israel must have been in their day, looked on the scene with wonder and amazement, hardly knowing what to expect next, but fearing the worst. The gathering of ministers on the platform reviewed the situation with no little dismay, knowing that unless God did a very unusual thing and backed up the speaker in a supernatural manner, the evil intruder, who had successfuly broken up religious services in the past, would now do so again. Some were much disturbed that the policemen had not been permitted to take charge of the situation and believed that this error of judgment would allow this demon-possessed man to not only ruin the meeting and thus bring reproach on the cause of Christ, but also might actually result in physical injury to the speaker.

The seconds passed, however, without the awaited climax happening. Presently it appeared that something was hindering the challenger from carrying out his evil designs. For some reason he was not proceeding with the execution of his boasts of physical violence, but was rather contenting himself in hissing and spitting and uttering the most fearful imprecations. Softly but determinedly the voice of the evangelist now could be heard rebuking the evil power that dominated the man. His words, spoken so quietly that they could be heard only a short distance, were saying, "Satan, because you have challenged the servant of God before this great congregation, you must now bow before me. In the name of Jesus Christ, you shall fall at my feet." The words were repeated several times. The challenger ceased to speak, and it was evident that it was now

he who was laboring under a strain. Strong as he and the wicked forces were that controlled him, strengthened by every evil spirit in the building, apparently they were gradually succumbing to another Power that was greater than they, a Power that responded at the whisper of the Name of Jesus! Soon it was evident that the man realized he was being overcome, but nothing he could do apparently could reverse the situation. A tense battle of spiritual forces now summoned every bit of strength that he had in him. Beads of perspiration broke out on his face as he put forth a last desperate effort to prevail. But it was all to no avail. Suddenly he who a few minutes before had so brazenly defied the man of God with his fearful threats and accusations, gave an awful groan and slumped to the floor sobbing in a hysterical manner. For quite a while he lay there writhing in the dust, as the evangelist calmly proceeded with the service as if nothing had happened.

Needless to say, the great congregation was awed by the scene that transpired before them, in which God so signally vindicated His servant, and loud praises to God filled the spacious auditorium. The policemen too, startled by what they had witnessed, openly acknowledged that God was in their midst. Need we record that in the healing service which followed, a wave of glory was manifest that will never be forgotten by those who were present. Many miracles of healing took place that night as a multitude of people were ministered to in the prayer line.

But who was this little man who spoke with such words of authority and whose ministry had been confirmed by such a remarkable demonstration of Divine power? His name was William Branham, of Jeffersonville, Indiana, and his ministry was to have wider and wider reverberations until, at the time of this writing, the effect of it has reached throughout the world.

His apostles, but have been borne witness to in all the centuries, and are frequent in our own time.

"An ounce of concrete illustration is sometimes worth a pound of abstract state-ment. Here is such a case happening with-in my own knowledge; one of several, in-deed, only that this is one of recent date, deed, only that this is one of recent date, within three or four months. It is the case of a young married woman afflicted with the disease popularly known as creeping paralysis, which, beginning at the lower extremities of the body, had been gradu-ally rising until it was in the neighbor-hood of her most vital parts. For six years she had not left her bed, moreover her stomach was so weak that for nearly two years she had been unable to retain solid years she had been unable to retain solid food, and in addition to this she had a curvature of the spine, which, to use her own words, had become 'entirely crooked.'

"Her physician had long since told her there was no help for her in man. When her paroxysms of pain were more than usually acute, he would come and administer an opiate, but more than that he was unable to do. She was a Christian woman of more than ordinary depth of character, and one day in prayer the conviction came upon her that God would show forth His glory in healing her. Soon after a neigh-boring pastor called, to whom she made known her belief, and requested him to pray with her. When the prayer was ended, in the presence of three witnesses she rose and walked around the room. She began at once to eat heartily, and in a few weeks was seated in her accustomed place in church. Moreover, an examination of her spine showed it to have become straight.

"In the first place this was a Christian wcman, one who believed the Bible to be the infallible Word of God, one who believed in Jesus Christ as her personal Saviour from sin through His sacrificial death. In the second place, she was a mem-ber in good standing of an evangelical church. In the third place, she believed in the prayer of faith. In the fourth place, she used no other means whatsoever to effect her cure. And in the fifth place, when she was healed she gave all the glory to her divine Healer."

A Remarkable Healing in the **McAlister** Meetings

Come with me and take a look into one of our Healing Meetings, a scene characteristic of what often happens. The place: Newville, Pa. How long ago? December, 1948. A broken-hearted father and mother bring their son, a boy four years old, Garry Lee. The poor little fellow had been injured in being born and his little body had not developed normally. Garry could not walk, or talk, or pick up anything and hold it in his little hands. His eyes were drawn to one side, both of them, until only barely more than the whites were visible. The father would then take over and even theough a working then take over and, even though a working man, he would only get one hour of sleep in a night—for poor little Garry Lee just slept twenty minutes through the day and one hour during the night as a rule.

I had the father to hold the boy up in clear sight of all the people and I asked that every person present, whether claim-ing to be a Christian or not, stand to their feet, raise their hands to heaven and pray. And they all did it. Some of the same kind of compassion that filled the breast of the Son of God while here on earth in human form and still fills His breast up there in the glory commenced to move in the breasts of all the people in the behalf of little Garry and his father and mother. What a touching scene! And what did the Lord Jesus Christ do about it? He too, up there, "touched with the feeling of our in-firmities," was moved to act. What hap-pened? That night, for the first night in a long, long time, and every night after, Garry slept the whole night through—and without any dope. Right away the parents were able to feed him out of a cup and in a sitting-up position, and without losing a single drop of his food. No more the front of his clothes all soaked wet, for there was no more slobbering—tongue no longer paralyzed. He was able to hold his head in an erect position and turn it about normally at will—spine no longer para-lyzed. The eyes came straight. Were the parents happy? Their joy knew no bounds. And friends, it all happened in one week's time.

I close by quoting from a sermon preached by Bishop Manning, Episcopalian, New York City: "Our faith is in One who does not change, One whose love and power are still able to cleanse the sinner and heal the sick, and give life from above to all who follow Him; One in whom we wholly trust for this life and for all eternity. 

I also discovered that I could read better with the healed eye than with the other one. Also, before you prayed, at approximately a distance of 6 feet (with the injured eye) people looked like trees, but now, praise God, they look like people. It is true also that the strained, tired look has gone from my eyes.

You also prayed for my kidneys. I was suffering from pyelitis, and only four weeks before had been confined to my bed with hard chills, high fever and excruciating pain. Only prayer brought me out of that bed. Twice since then I had slight chills, fever and much pain. When you prayed, the soreness and pain left.
